



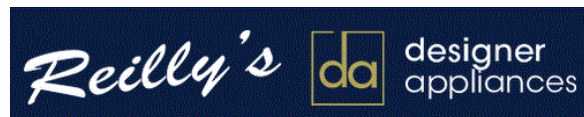
South Bendigo Athletic Club 2022 Club Run 12
